

1. Download the FT6381 Communication Software


- ※ If you are downloading directly on an Android device, please refer to the image in Step 4 for the download process, and then proceed to "2. Installing the FT6381 Communication Software."
- ※ If you are downloading the app on a Windows PC and then copying it to an Android device, please proceed from Step 1.

Step 1: Connect your PC and Android device via USB.

Step 2: Swipe down from the top of the screen on your Android device and tap "Charging this device via USB."



Step 3: In [USB Preferences], select [File transfer/Android Auto].




Step 4: On the HIOKI website, go to Service & Support > Downloads and search for "FT6381"

Step 5: Download the software (ft6381_v□□□) from "FT6381 Communication Software."


Step 6: Open File Explorer, navigate to the "Internal shared storage" of your Android device, and copy the previously downloaded "ft6381_v□□□.apk" file into the Download folder.

2. Installing the FT6381 Communication Software


Step 1: From the home screen of your Android device, search for "Files" and select it.



Step 2: Select the Apps.



Step 3: Install the FT6381 Communication Software from the "App installation file(APKs)"



- ※ The settings may vary depending on the device model and OS version.
- ※ If an error occurs during installation, please uninstall any existing FT6381 Communication Software and try installing it again.
- ※ If an error occurs during installation, please follow the steps below to grant installation permission for the FT6381 Communication Software.

Step 1: Tap the "Settings" icon, type "unknown" in the search bar at the top of the screen, and tap "Install unknown apps".

Step 2: Select FT6381 Communication Software, and grant installation permission by enabling "Allow from this source".
